241 – AP English Literature and Composition

An AP English Literature student:

- has strong writing skills, including command of the rules of English grammar, a strong and varied writing style, and mastery of the mechanics of English;
- accepts the major responsibility for her/his own learning;
- has a minimum score of 60 on each of the Critical Reading and Writing sections of the PSAT taken in October of the junior year;
- is enrolled in English III - Honors 1 (232) with a minimum average of 93 or English III – Honors (233) with a minimum average of 95;
- will be recommended for enrollment in AP English Literature by the English III teacher.

Enrollment in any AP course in the fall of the new school year is always contingent on meeting the prerequisites listed in *Shamrock Studies* in June of the preceding school year.

Once course selections are completed (4/30), students may not change their AP course choices.
