

# **SNOW BALL DANCE GUIDELINES**

Any student who does not adhere to the guidelines below will not be allowed into the dance. Miss Peixoto and Mr. Crossen are willing to answer any questions beforehand. ## **Dress Code: Semiformal Attire**

### **Ladies**

- Dresses must be tasteful and have a modest cut. Bare midriffs and plunging necklines are NOT acceptable.
- Strapless dresses are acceptable (as long as no chest is visible).
- Your dress or skirt should be no shorter than your fingertips (with your arms at your side). Otherwise, leggings must be worn.
- Jeans, shorts, and mini-skirts are NOT acceptable.

### **Gentlemen**

- Dress pants and collared shirts are required; however, ties are optional.
- Jeans, shorts, t-shirts, and hats are NOT acceptable.

\*If these guidelines are not upheld, you will either be sent home or asked to call your parents to bring you something else to wear. The school administration will be the final judge regarding appropriate attire.
