Be Yourself

- In the spirit of a **\$5.00 TAG** (*Tasteful Approved Garments*) Day, students are asked to adhere to these guidelines keeping in mind that the purpose is to show spirit in a tasteful, non-distracting manner.
- This list is not meant to be exhaustive. Good taste and judgment must be utilized.
- If a student comes to a TAG Day in school uniform, he/she must wear the uniform in its entirety following the uniform guidelines in the Student Handbook.
- Students who violate TAG Day guidelines are subject to losing these privileges or being sent home.

GUIDELINES:

1. All clothing is permissible as long as it falls within the following guidelines:
 - **SHIRTS OR ADORNMENTS THAT PERTAIN TO OR ARE AFFILIATED WITH ALCOHOL, TOBACCO, WEAPONS, MUSIC GROUPS, ETC. ARE NOT PERMITTED.*
 - ***ANY ITEMS THAT ARE QUESTIONABLE WILL NOT BE ALLOWED.*
2. ALL SHIRTS AND BLOUSES MUST BE LONG ENOUGH TO BE TUCKED IN WITH NO MIDRIFF OR BACK SHOWING WHEN STANDING, SITTING, OR BENDING. ALL NECKLINES MUST NOT BE PLUNGING.
3. BLOUSES WITH SPAGHETTI STRAPS, TUBE TOPS, TANK TOPS, OR HALTER TOPS ARE NOT PERMITTED.
4. FOR BOTTOMS:
 - A. JEANS ARE PERMISSIBLE IF THEY FIT PROPERLY AND ARE NOT TORN OR DISTRESSED. LEGGINGS/ JEGGINGS/YOGA PANTS ARE NOT ALLOWED.
 - B. SWEATPANTS ARE PERMISSIBLE ONLY IF THEY ARE LOOSE FITTING AND DO NOT REVEAL BOXERS OR BARE MIDRIFF (NO YOGA PANTS)
 - C. STUDENTS WHO OPT TO WEAR SHORTS, SKIRTS, OR DRESSES ARE TO BE SURE THAT THEY ARE AT LEAST AS LONG AS THE END OF ONE'S FINGERTIPS WHEN ARE ARMS ARE PLACED STRAIGHT DOWN
 - D. NO LEGGINGS, JEGGINGS, YOGA PANTS, MINI SKIRTS, SHORT SHORTS, OR ANY BOTTOMS OTHER THAN THOSE EXPRESSLY ADDRESSED IN THESE GUIDELINES ARE PERMITTED (IE. ONLY JEANS, LOOSE SWEATPANTS, AND APPROPRIATE SHORTS, SKIRTS, AND/OR DRESSES)
5. TORN OR DISTRESSED CLOTHING IS NOT PERMITTED.
6. MALES ARE NOT ALLOWED TO WEAR EARRINGS.
7. HAIR SHOULD BE STYLED APPROPRIATELY. HAIR GUIDELINES DO NOT CHANGE ON TAG DAYS.
8. ANY STYLE, ITEM, OR ADORNMENT THAT IS CONSIDERED INAPPROPRIATE OR DISTRACTING TO THE EDUCATIONAL ENVIRONMENT WILL NOT BE ALLOWED.
