# Additional Notes

## 2011-12

### **Yearbooks**

Members of the Class of 2012 DO NOT NEED to purchase a yearbook. The senior yearbook is included in the senior fee. Seniors MUST have their yearbook picture taken by Chestnut Hill Studios. Parents are under no obligation to purchase the portrait from Chestnut Hill but only pictures taken by Chestnut Hill will appear in the yearbook. Chestnut Hill will contact each family to set up an appointment. If the picture is not taken by the yearbook deadline for senior portraits (October 1) the picture will NOT appear in the 2012 yearbook. Baby Ads for graduating seniors will be purchased online. Information concerning the purchase of the ads will be emailed to senior parents after the start of the school year.

### **School Pictures**

Students (*grades 9-11*) will have pictures taken for the yearbook on their Orientation Day. An envelope from the photographer will be included in your August packet in the event you wish to purchase a school picture or package. *Students not in compliance with all uniform guidelines will not be photographed.*

### **P a r k i n g Permits**

Students who drive and park at Bishop Feehan High School will be required to purchase a 2011-2012 parking permit for \$20. A parking permit will give the school information to help with security, attendance and accidents. Enclosed is the parking permit application. Please fill out and return to the Student Life Office (Room 212) during the summer. Parking placards will be distributed in your August packet. These placards must be attached to the front mirror facing the window when school starts.

### **Driver's Education**

Bishop Feehan High School offers Driver Education Classroom courses here at the school all year. The course is offered by an independent contractor which meets the state requirements. Students must be 15 years 9 months to start the class. The classes are held in Mercy Hall- Classrooms 95 & 96. For details and a registration form, those interested may register in the Student Life Office (Room 212) with Mrs. Force beginning September 7, 2011.

### **Course Schedules**

Tentative 2011-12 course schedules are distributed to all students in June. **Final** schedules are distributed to students on Orientation Day. The final schedules will include class, period, teacher, room number, homeroom, and Guidance Counselor. It is important to note that courses are assigned based on student requests and staff availability. Changes to course requests cannot be accommodated during the summer months.

### **Book Sales**

Textbooks are available for purchase through our online book reseller, MBS Direct. A link to the MBS website, instructions for purchasing books, and our 2011-12 required textbook list, are all available on the school website under the "Academics" tab beginning in mid-June. The online bookstore opens on July 1st. We strongly encourage families to begin the book buying process as early as possible to avoid backorders. Students are advised not to mark or write their names in any new books until they receive their final schedules in August. A book swap is scheduled for June 17<sup>th</sup> at 6:00-7:30 P.M. in the school cafeteria. Parents and students must understand that Bishop Feehan High School is not responsible for monitoring transactions at the book swap. It is best to attend the book swap as an "educated consumer" in order to assure that the correct text books are purchased.

### **Summer Learning Experience**

Every student is required to complete the *2011 Summer Learning Experience*. This program is designed to give each student a broader choice of enrichment possibilities by offering experiences in literature, film, and the arts with emphasis on our spiritual mission. A detailed description and program requirements will be posted on the school website by June 20<sup>th</sup>. Students are expected to complete their reflection before they return to school in the fall. Specific due dates for the reflection and group discussions will be posted towards the end of the summer.

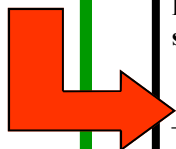

## **RULES FOR THE BFHS PARKING LOT**

1. Only FEEHAN students who have submitted parking registration and have received a placard will be allowed to drive to school.
2. Make sure your car is locked at all times. Bishop Feehan does not assume responsibility for contents left in your car or damages to your car.
3. Cars are not to be backed into spaces.
4. You can go to your car only for the purpose of leaving the campus. You may not sit in any cars during your free period. This includes loitering in the parking lot when your free period is last period of the day. Juniors or seniors who are free last period of the day may leave campus; however, students with athletic or extracurricular commitments after-school are to remain on-campus to minimize traffic at dismissal time.
5. Excessive speeding, loud radio playing, and horseplay are not permitted in the FEEHAN parking lot.
6. Your car is considered part of your property on-campus. Your car is subject to being searched by the administration.
7. You must enter and exit in the specified manner along the paved routes.
8. The BISHOP FEEHAN PARKING PLACARD must be hung on your rear view mirror of your vehicle. Unauthorized cars will be towed away at the owner's expense.
9. You are not to have any offensive or controversial materials (stickers, license plates, etc.) on your vehicle.
11. Do not throw trash in the parking lot. You are responsible for keeping the parking lot clean.
12. Please exercise good judgment and obey the rules of the road while driving to and from school. Traffic violations or improper driving may result in the suspension of parking privileges or disciplinary action. Students should not be on their cell phones while driving and all students should have their seat belts buckled.
13. You may not give permission to another student to use your parking placard during school hours. You may not give your parking placard to another person if you leave FEEHAN.
14. If you drive another car to school, you must notify the office immediately and complete the proper paperwork.
15. The fee is \$20.00 per year payable at the time of application. Replacement parking placards will cost \$20.00 each.
16. Students must remain parked in their spot until all riders are in the car.
17. If you violate any of the above rules, you may lose your parking privileges. No refunds will be given at any time for any reason.



# DRESS CODE

## 2011-2012

Uniforms are a distinct indication of a student's connection to the school. Representing the school in a positive manner is an expectation in all areas of student life, including professional dress and grooming. Handbook regulations concerning the uniform are applicable at all times, whether on or off campus. It is both the parents' and the school's responsibility to instill this mindset in the student body. It is expected that the uniform will be neat, clean, and in satisfactory condition. In addition to handbook guidelines, any other attire or grooming patterns determined to cause distractions are not acceptable. *The administration is the final authority on interpretations of the dress code.*

Shoes	Leather dress shoes that are black or brown with a closed toe, closed back, and heel are permitted. No other shoes ( <i>including all fabric and suede shoes/slippers, workboots or UGGs</i> ) are permitted, and shoes must remain in good repair and tied at all times. A note must be given to the Vice Principal of Student Life if a foot injury requires the wearing of non-uniform shoes. If the injury requires the wearing of non-uniform shoes for more than a three week period, the student must wear plain all-black leather athletic shoes.
Outerwear	The forest green v-neck school sweater/vest with the Feehan Spire logo purchased from Donnelly's must be worn between October 1 and April 30 inclusive, otherwise the sweater/vest is optional. Students wearing non-approved outerwear to school must remove it each morning by the start of homeroom at 7:40 A.M.. Sweat clothes, visible thermal underwear, and hats are not permitted. Sunglasses may only be visible outside of the building.
T.A.G. (Dress Down Days)	At various times during the school year, students are given the opportunity to come to school out of uniform. <i>T.A.G. (Tasteful, Approved Garments) Days</i> usually require a small fee to support a charitable cause or to recognize a specific activity or achievement. On any day that students are allowed to be out of uniform, posted standards must be followed. These days are considered a privilege that may be revoked for individuals failing to follow guidelines. Guidelines will be posted by the administration throughout the school.

Skirt	Skirts or solid color tan slacks must be purchased from Donnelly's. Skirts may not be shorter than two inches above the knee. ( <b>N.B.A</b> good rule of thumb is that 7 "bands" of the plaid from the waist band.) The skirts may not be rolled, secured by safety pins, etc.	Slacks	Solid color tan slacks purchased from Donnelly's Uniform Shop are required.
Blouse	White or blue pastel blouses with a Feehan (shamrock) pocket logo must be purchased from Donnelly's. Blouses are to be tucked in to the skirt at all times. Fitted/tapered blouses are not allowed. All buttons except the top one must be buttoned. Knit shirts and oversized blouses are not permitted. Only plain white T-shirts and undergarments are permitted under the blouse. Long sleeved plain white t-shirts are permitted only if worn with long sleeved blouses.	Shirt	White or blue pastel shirts with a Feehan (shamrock) pocket logo must be purchased from Donnelly's. Shirts are to be tucked in to the pants at all times. If the top button is not buttoned, this button must be covered by the tie. All other buttons must be buttoned. Knit shirts and oversized shirts are not permitted. Only plain white T-shirts are permitted under the shirt. Long sleeved plain white t-shirts are permitted only if worn with long sleeved shirts.
Sweater/Vest	The forest green v-neck school sweater/vest with the Feehan Spire logo purchased at Donnelly's must be worn between October 1 and April 30 inclusive, otherwise, the sweater is optional.	Sweater/ vest	The forest green v-neck school sweater/vest with the Feehan Spire logo purchased at Donnelly's must be worn between October 1 and April 30 inclusive, otherwise, the sweater/vest is optional.
Tights	Green tights purchased at Bishop Feehan or Donnelly's are required any time and place that the uniform is worn. Tights are to be free of holes and runs. If a student's tights are deemed unacceptable, the student will be consigned a pair by the Bookstore for payment the following school day.	Tie	A Donnelly's school tie must be on by the start of homeroom at 7:40 A.M. and may be removed after the dismissal bell.
Hair	Hairstyles may not be distracting, as determined by the administration. Hair must be clean and styled in a moderate fashion, and hair guidelines do not change on <i>T.A.G. (Dress Down) Days</i> .	Belt	Black or dark brown belts with buckles must be visible. Belts and buckles are to be free from any inappropriate or distracting words or symbols.
Makeup, accessories, and jewelry	A limited amount of makeup and jewelry is permitted. Rings through body pierced areas are restricted to the ear. There is a limit of two small earring per ear. Any style or accessory considered by the administration to be distracting will not be allowed.	Socks	Socks must cover the foot to the anklebone and be clearly visible above the shoe.
Body markings	Body markings such as tattoos or those made by ink pens must be covered while on school grounds or while representing the school in an extra-curricular activity.  Body Piercing is not permitted	Hair	Hairstyles may not be distracting, as determined by the administration. Hair must be tapered (gradual change in length) and may not touch the collar. Extensions will not be given for hair appointments. Hair guidelines do not change on <i>T.A.G. (Dress Down) Days</i> .
