## Why get a flu shot?



### To stay ahead of changing viruses



Because influenza viruses are always changing, the flu vaccine is reviewed annually and updated, as needed, to keep up.



### Helps protect friends and family



By getting your flu shot, you avoid exposing those around you, especially those who are unable to get the flu shot themselves.



### Keeps you from missing out



If you get the flu, you'll likely need to stay home from work or school while you recover. You may even have to sit out from an important event or holiday.



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If interested in having your child receive their flu shot for the 2019-2020 season, please fill out the consent form provided and have your child return the form to Nurse Cindy Knight, by October 18<sup>th</sup>.

We can provide a copy of proof of your child's flu vaccine to their primary care physician if you fill out the physician's name and location on the consent form.
