



Sell Your Used Books from June 1st until June 30th

-Student-Managed Buyback Instructions-

Selling back your books is an easy way to get money back for your books.

1. At the main buyback page (<https://www.k12sd.com/Orders/BuybackItems>), enter the ISBN of each book that you would like to sell back. The ISBN is often above the barcode on the back of the book and on the copyright page on the inside of the book. Books which are eligible for buyback are textbooks which are in fair or better condition. If a book isn't returning any search results, it's either being entered incorrectly or is ineligible.
2. After creating a list, check off each book which you would like to sell back and select the condition in which you will be returning the book. We will be verifying the condition upon arrival at our warehouse. A link to view condition definitions may be found on the page.
3. Payment will be issued to you via check. Enter the name and address to which the check should be addressed.
4. Check off the box that signifies your agreement with the terms of the buyback (please read these).
5. Select "Submit and Print". Your buyback request will be submitted to K12 Student Direct. Please place the printed confirmation/packing slip and books in a box or envelope and use the USPS mailing label provide to ship the books back to us.
6. Drop the package with your U.S. Postal Service carrier. We recommend that you insure your package for the appropriate value so that should the package be damaged in transit you will have recourse with the carrier.
7. Upon arrival at our warehouse the buyback orders will be processed and payment will be issued within 3 to 5 weeks.

Textbook Condition Definitions

Textbooks submitted for buy back must be in one of the following three conditions. Similarly, books being returned as part of the rental program will be subject to the same condition definitions.

Very Good: Books must appear in close to new condition, free from highlighting, underlining, and notes.

Good: Books must appear in original cover, free from excessive wear: bends, breaks, tears, repair tape, liquid damage, and any foreign substance. Books should only contain very little, if any, highlighting, underlining, or notes. Book binding must be strong and undamaged.

Fair: Books must appear with original cover. Moderate wear is expected.

Unacceptable:

- Fire or smoke damage
- Medium to large tears to the cover or pages, including damage to the binding
- Missing pages
- Water, moisture damage, or mold
- Workbooks or manuals with writing in them
